

#### Soft Peanut Butter Cookies

1 & 1/2 cups all purpose flour, spooned & leveled

1/2 tsp baking soda

1/4 tsp salt

1/2 cup (115 grams) unsalted butter, softened

3/4 cup (150 grams) light brown sugar packed

1/4 cup (50 grams) granulated sugar

3/4 cup (190 grams) creamy peanut butter

1 large egg room temperature

1 tsp pure vanilla extract

3 TBS granulated sugar optional

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats and set aside.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, and salt. Set aside.
- 3. In the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, or in a large mixing bowl using a handheld mixer, cream the butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar together for 1 to 2 minutes or until well combined.
- 4. Mix in the peanut butter, egg, and vanilla extract until fully combined, making sure to stop and scrape down the sides of the bowl as needed.
- 5. Add the dry ingredients and mix until just combined.
- 6. Place the 3 TBS of granulated sugar in a small bowl. Using a 1.5 TBS cookie scoop, scoop the cookie dough, roll into a ball, and coat in the granulated sugar. Place each ball of cookie dough onto the prepared baking sheets, making sure to leave a little room between each one. Gently press each one down with a fork to make a small criss-cross pattern.
- 7. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes or until the tops of the cookies are set. Remove from the oven and allow to cool on the baking sheet for 5 to 10 minutes, then carefully transfer the cookies to a wire rack to cool completely.
